How does it all work? We invest in grassroots organizations that improve the lives of children and youth challenged by poverty, injustice, and discrimination. We are committed to advancing the rights of children and youth, and we fund organizations that are tackling tough issues in our four thematic focus areas: education, gender equity, youth empowerment, and freedom from violence and exploitation. What will you be doing? You will develop and drive a strategy for investing in and building the capacity of children- and youth-serving organizations in Latin America. You will build direct relationships with grantees in the region, serve as a mentor, and help connect grantees to resources to strengthen their capacity. You will also contribute your knowledge and experience beyond Latin America to advance our global work.

Are you the right person? We would love it if you have experience in one of our thematic focus areas and can support learning and growth for us and our partners in this area. You know the realities of grassroots organizations – how to assess strengths and challenges, and how to coach and mentor. You have experience in Latin America, a strong network of contacts in the region, and the knowledge to build, fund, and lead a strategy. Your entrepreneurial spirit shows that you are not afraid to take risks and learn from failure. You have a fierce commitment to learning and to sharing what you know. You have experience leading a team and use your emotional intelligence to inspire results. You are excited to speak and write about the issues that grantees tackle and have the communication skills to do it well; and you are eager to partner with our fundraising team to identify and steward new opportunities.
