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



Subgroup Methodology and Differences

Subgroup Methodology

Geography: Using GFC's grantee list, and in consultation with GFC, CEP tagged grantees into 4 geographical groups: Africa, Americas, Europe and Eurasia, and Asia.

Percent of Budget Funded: Using grantees' survey responses, CEP tagged grantees into 4 categories based on the proportion of their yearly budget which was funded by the grant received.

Subgroup Differences

Geography: Similar to 2018, while no group consistently rates higher or lower than others, there are some trends*. Specifically, ratings from grantees in Asia trend lower than grantees in other geographical areas.

Percent of Budget Funded: Similar to 2018, while no group consistently rates higher or lower than others, there are some trends*. Specifically ratings from grantees whose budgets are less than 5% funded trend lower on almost all measures in the survey. Ratings from grantees whose budgets are more than 20% funded trend higher on several measures in the survey.

*CEP calls outs trends in subgroups where the mean for a subgroup is at least 0.3 larger or smaller than the mean for GFC overall.





Median Grant Size



Median Organizational Budget




Proportion of grantees responding 'No, this funding was not restricted to a specific use (i.e. general operating, core support)'


Proportion of grantees receiving multi-year unrestricted grants

Proportion of grantees responding 'No, this funding was not restricted to a specific use (i.e. general operating, core support)' and report receiving grants for two years or longer





Overall, how would you rate GFC's impact on your field?





How well does GFC understand the field in which you work?





To what extent has GFC advanced the state of knowledge in your field?





Overall, how would you rate GFC's impact on your local community?





How well does GFC understand the local community in which you work?





Overall, how would you rate GFC's impact on your organization?





How well does GFC understand your organization's strategy and goals?





How aware is GFC of the challenges that your organization is facing?





How comfortable do you feel approaching GFC if a problem arises?





To what extent did GFC exhibit candor about GFC's perspectives on your work during this grant?






To what extent did GFC exhibit compassion for those affected by your work during this grant?



How often do/did you have contact with your program officer during this grant?





How often do/did you have contact with your program officer during this grant? - By Subgroup





Who most frequently initiated the contact you had with your program officer?





Who most frequently initiated the contact you had with your program officer? - By Subgroup





Has your main contact at GFC changed in the past six months?







How consistent was the information provided by different communication resources, both personal and written, that you used to learn about GFC?






How well do you understand the way in which the work funded by this grant fits into GFC's broader efforts? - By Subgroup

To what extent is GFC open to ideas from grantees about its strategy?













Are you aware of any action GFC has taken in response to the COVID-19 pandemic? - By Subgroup















Are the efforts funded by this grant primarily meant to benefit historically disadvantaged groups?





Are the efforts funded by this grant primarily meant to benefit historically disadvantaged groups? - By Subgroup









How helpful was participating in GFC's selection process in strengthening the organization/program funded by the grant?











To what extent was GFC's reporting process straightforward?



















Median Grant Size





Median Hours Spent on Proposal and Selection Process



Median Hours Spent on Monitoring, Reporting and Evaluation Process Per Year









Did you receive any non-monetary support from GFC during this grant period? - By Subgroup




Subgroup: Percent of Budget Funded

How would you describe the benefit - to your organization or work - of any non-monetary support that you received?





Have you ever requested support from GFC to help strengthen your organization?





Have you ever requested support from GFC to help strengthen your organization? - By Subgroup




Subgroup: Percent of Budget Funded









Roles Beyond Grantmaking


Thinking about the roles GFC plays beyond grantmaking, which role(s) is most important for GFC to play in the future? (Please select up to 3 options)





Grantees were asked to provide any suggestions for how the Fund could improve. The 72 grantees that responded to the survey provided a total of 35 distinct suggestions. These suggestions were thematically categorized by CEP and grouped into the topics below.

Grantmaking (43% N=15)

- Larger Grants (N = 5)
 - "GFC should increase the funding to local partner"
 - "Increase the amount of the annual grant, according to the needs, responsibility and commitment with which each organization assumes"
 - "To increase funding for younger organizations in amount and length of time so they can develop to sustain the change effected by the support they received"
- Grant Type (N = 4)
 - "Giving unrestricted funding with specific guidelines."
 - "Give direct institutional support funding"
- Longer Grants (N = 4)
 - "For the level of involvment and time required from our part, we would usually expect a bigger multi-year financial commitment from a funder"
 - "GFC should be a better funder if it gets engaged with the grassroot organisations in a long term financing of specific program which must be for instance at least 5 years."
- Other (N = 2)
 - "In terms of planning, it would be helpful to know how long GFC support will continue."

Interactions (20% N=7)

- More Frequent Interactions (N = 4)
 - "FACE TO FACE meeting atleast once in a year to understand GFC."
 - "Monthly catch up with grantee."

 - "That the officers have more time to make visits and participate in the planning and development of local events."

 - "Partners and GFC develop joint proposals to attract more funding windows."

 - "Provide training or workshop meeting in non virtual in coming days when Covid over, which will be more effective for us and regarding for funding, GFC exist better funder."

 - "More social media campaigns jointly. That will give us better reach."

- Funding Focus (N = 3)
 - "To try to cover every small place in the world where children do not have all the rights and freedoms, to help more and more young organizations to
 encourage issues about children."

Reporting Process (6% N=2)

- Streamline (N = 2)
 - "For a general operating grant, we find GFC's reporting requirements to be lengthy and burdensome. We do not feel the level of reporting required corresponds with the size of the grant and the unrestricted nature of the support. Most of our other general operating grants request a short update on our work, our achievements and results for the reporting period, and any challenges we have faced. GFC asks for reporting on specific activities, despite

the fact that the support is for general operating. This in turn creates a situation where we feel at times the funding isn't truly for general operating, but rather GFC would like to see us use their grant to support the activities they ask for reporting on. We would like to see GFC revamp their reporting so that it better aligns with their vision and grantmaking philosophy. We understand that GFC has donors they are reporting to on specific activities but we think there are faster/more streamlined ways to collect information on specific activities/outputs such as surveys rather than long narrative reports."
