The Phoenix Way: Children and Youth Funding Round Application Questions and Guidance

Thank you for your interest in applying to The Phoenix Way: Children and Youth Funding Round! These guidelines set out the questions we ask in our application and give some advice about what we are looking for in your answers. We are excited about learning about your work and organisation.

- Applications must be submitted in English but please do not worry too much about spelling or grammar
- We have not set word limits on any of the questions but this does not mean that you have to provide lots and lots of information - short bullet points are completely fine as long as you answer the question

In this section of the application, we want to gather some basic information about your organisation. This includes your name, key contacts, location, income and registration status. Questions marked with an **asterisk*** are required questions.

Name*

Please enter the first and last name of the person completing the application. The platform will automatically enter the name you entered when you registered unless you change this.

Email*

Please enter the email address of the person completing the application. The platform will automatically enter the email you entered when you registered unless you change this.

Name of organisation or group*

Section 2 - Your organisation/group

In this section of the application, we want to learn more about your organisation and group's leadership and about the impact of the cost of living crisis on your work. Questions marked with an **asterisk*** are required questions.

Tell us about your organisation's structure and leadership. How do you meet the criteria that 70% of your leadership must be from Black and/or racially minoritised communities?*

Please use this space to give us more information on the way your organisation is set up and run. What does the leadership look like in your organisation or group? By leadership we mean CEO/Managing Director/Founders, Directors, non-executive Directors, Trustees, Advisory Board Members, or those responsible for the day to day decision making and running of the organisation. We recognise that this can look different in each organisation.

How much funding would you like to apply for?*

Grants will be for project funding of between £30,000 - £50,000 for one year. Please enter an amount between £30,000 - £50,000.

Why are you applying for this amount?*

Please provide a brief summary of the impact this funding would have on your organisation. This question is not about the detail of how you would spend the money but is more focused on the wider benefit this funding would have for your organisation. For example, if you are seeking to fund a new project which otherwise wouldn't exist, or you'd like to expand the activities on offer in an existing project.

How would your organisation spend the grant if you are successful in securing funding?*

Please use this space to outline a rough plan of what you'd like to spend the money on if your application is successful. This question is focused on the detail of how you would plan to spend the money, so you can list the costs you'd like us to fund using budget headings. For example if you're applying for staffing costs, you can say 'salaries'. We know that your circumstances may change so this question is just to give us an idea of what is important to you.

Section 3 - Your work

In this section of the application we want to learn more about your organisation's work, your vision, values and motivations and your approach to working with children and young people. We would also like to understand more about how you understand and approach youth violence. Questions marked with an **asterisk*** are required questions.

What is the main purpose or goal of your organisation? What are you set up to do?*

Please use this space to tell us about the main reason your organisation or group exists. This could include your mission or vision and/or the big goals that you are working towards. You can also use this space to tell us about the overall work and activities of your organisation. For example, what are you most proud of? What makes your organisation unique? What are your relationships like with the communities you work with? What else is important for you to share?

What type of project are you delivering?*

How will you keep track of this? How do you know your work is making a positive difference to the communities you are part of? You may have examples of previous work, or a high demand for your activities which you'd like to tell us about.

Tell us about the children and young people that you want to work with through this project*

Please use this space to tell us about the children and young people that your organisation works with. Do you work with children and young people under the age of 18? If you know how many children and young people you'd like to reach through this project, you can tell us here.

Do you believe your work could reduce the likelihood of children and young people becoming involved in violence?*

This funding is aimed at preventing children and young people becoming involved in violence, and we're only looking to support projects that reach children and young people with the highest risk factors for becoming involved with violence. We'd like to understand how you believe that your project will achieve this ultimate aim. Please use this space to tell us about your approach to preventing or reducing youth violence in

your work and activities. How do you know they are at high risk of becoming involved in violence? Are they impacted by systemic issues and wider structural disadvantages? How does your approach help prevent or reduce youth violence? What else is important for you to share?

How do you find the children and young people you work with?*

Is your project targeted through referrals or other processes that allow you to assess that the children & young people you're working with are at high risk of becoming involved with violence? How do you reach young people in your community? Do you work with children who have been referred by statutory services e.g. Youth Offending Teams, school councillors, police?

What percentage of your work is targeted at young people at high risk of becoming involved in violence and what percentage is open to all children and young people?*

Please use this space to give us a breakdown of the young people you work with. Do you work directly with those at risk of becoming involved with violence, or facing systemic issues and wider structural disadvantage?

How does your organisation keep children and young people safe?*

Please use this space to tell us about the ways that your organisation or group keeps the children and young people you work with safe from harm and abuse. For example, do you have a safeguarding policy and/or procedure? Do you train your staff on safeguarding?

How are children and young people included in decision making within your organisation?*

Please use this space to tell us about your approach to including children and young people in decision making within your organisation. For example, are children and young people included in your Board or leadership groups? Do you ask for feedback and suggestions on activities and ways of working? What else is important for you to share?
